

FLEXIBLE PROGRAMS

Transitions - Focus Individual Post grade 10 Pathways

Involves primarily students from grades 8, 9 and 10 and includes students accessing mentored learning opportunities e.g. work placements, transition TAFE courses, industry visits and short term tailored school based courses e.g. childcare projects and beauty and grooming etc. and host students. Placements and short courses vary depending on student needs and availability.

Where necessary a student's programme when on the school campus is altered to meet literacy and numeracy needs.

Grounds and School Projects
